VVH 60 Day scheme

Council has been advised that the ACT Liberal party will support the Council request to introduce a 60 day usage of Concessionally Registered vehicles if they win the ACT Government election in October 2020.

Council is urging affiliated clubs and individual members, to write to candidates standing for election pointing out that council has been advocating to the ACT Government since June 2018 for the introduction of the 60 day usage scheme to fall into line with all other justifications, and has not had the courtesy of a reply.
