Recently we noticed some unusual transactions in our Bank Account. After numerous telephone calls, emails and personal visits to the bank nothing was happening. After contacting the banking Ombudsman, the bank investigated and refunded these transactions. While we did receive an apology from the bank, there was no admission on their part that the transactions were fraudulent.

I have also been involved with the Australian Confederation of Motor Clubs (ACMC) since I was voted in as the Vice President (for the last two years). This Confederation represents over 300,000 enthusiasts and their families. It was here in last November that I learnt the National Transport Commission (NTC) was looking at Nationalising Vehicle Standards Bulletin 14.

In 2024, transport ministers endorsed a high-level national approach to light vehicle modifications, starting with an update to Vehicle Standards Bulletin 14 (VSB14). VSB 14 is the National Code of Practice for light vehicle construction and modification that sets out how vehicles can be legally and safely modified.



The idea of the Nationalisation is to meet all jurisdictions needs and to make it simple to read for all. I look forward in dealing with the NTC and Access Canberra over the proposed updates. I will be sending out a separate communique very shortly of what has been going on from an NSW point of view.

Remembering NSW currently works with Vehicle Standards Information (VSI) sheets. VSI 06 is their light vehicle modifications document which has been proposed to the NTC.

Council has received a draft revised MOU see registrar comments below. Further details at the next council meeting.

Just a little reminder each affiliated club is supposed to nominate 2 delegates to represent them at Council meetings. Ideally, they should attend all meetings. The next General Meeting of Council is in October, to be held at 7:30pm on Thursday 16th at the Spanish Australian Club in Narrabundah.

A representative attendance would be appreciated.

Well, that's enough from your council President, enjoy all your club runs now and, in the future, and I hope to see everyone safe at the next meeting.

December 2025

I am pleased to announce Wheels 2026 will be going ahead on Sunday 22nd March, and it is returning to Canberra. Wheels 2026 will be held at Thoroughbred Park.

The gates will be open from 8:00am, but we ask that all vehicles should arrive between 9am and 10am. We intend to close the gates at 10am, so don't be late. Once parked all vehicles will be on static display until 1:30pm, i.e. after the presentations at 1pm. During the event the gates will be closed, so no movements will be allowed as a condition of our Public Liability Insurance. We expect a lot of pedestrian traffic in the display area during this time.

Of note for Wheels 2026:

- 1. Prepaid tickets (purchased through affiliated clubs) will cost \$5.00 per vehicle. Tickets sold at the gates on the day will cost \$10.00 per vehicle.
- 2. Passengers and pedestrian visitors will incur no charge for entry.
- 3. There will be a dedicated gate operating for prepaid entrants and a second for those without tickets for payment on the day.
- 4. Motorcycles will be able to access the venue via a third Gate.
- 5. Food and coffee vans will be available on the day.
- 6. There will be a section allocated to Trades and automotive vendors.

I request from each club the following:

- 1. We have three gates to man from 8am until 10am, therefore we need volunteers to man the gates for this period. Two volunteers per gate will be needed for each of the three hours. The Traffic Marshals will also be needed to assist with directing vehicles to their allocated areas.
- 2. We therefore seek assistance from clubs to nominate Gate & Traffic Marshals.
- 3. Please consider this request and provide your club's & personnel's names to me ASAP?
- 4. A Marshals briefing will be held on-site on at 3:00pm on Saturday 21st March. It should be over within the hour.
- 5. Due to the short timing of this notification, we will need the number of expected vehicles from each club as soon as possible. This will greatly assist in planning the layout for the site.
- 6. Tickets can be purchased via an EFT transaction direct to CACTMC.
- 7. Provide Club Name/Number and the number of tickets your club requires.
- 8. Invoices will be issued to Clubs for eft payments.
- 9. Pre-purchased tickets will be available for collection at the January, February and March CACTMC meetings ONLY, once payment has been confirmed.
